
# 🙀 Day 1: Delhi to Haridwar (230 km / Approx. 6 hrs)





# 🌄 Day 2: Haridwar to Gangnani (Approx. 7 hrs)

Located at an altitude of 3,100 meters, Gangotri is where Goddess Ganga is believed to have descended to Earth, answering the prayers of King Bhagirath. Take a holy dip in the Bhagirathi River, perform puja, and experience the spiritual stillness of the Himalayas.

On your return, enjoy peaceful moments and attend a serene Ganga Aarti at the resort's private riverbank or your hotel.


#### 🜿 Day 4: Gangnani to Haridwar (Approx. 7 hrs)


Begin the return journey to Haridwar, stopping at Chamba for tea and a light meal. Take in the changing landscape as the Himalayas slowly merge into the plains.


Use your free evening in Haridwar to revisit the ghats or explore local temples and ashrams.

After breakfast, check out and proceed towards Delhi, marking the end of your soulful journey to the source of the Ganges.


This yatra is not just a journey to the mountains—but a step closer to inner peace, spiritual cleansing, and divine connection.


