
Day 01: Gorakhpur to Pokhara - Your Spiritual Journey Begins





If time permits, enjoy a leisurely stroll through the bustling Thamel Market, where you can shop for souvenirs, handicrafts, and experience the local vibe.




Day 04: Kathmandu to Bhairawa – Gorakhpur: Journey's End with Divine Blessings
