

Next, step into the birthplace of Mata Sita — Janakpur Dham, a hidden gem of the Ramayana circuit. Offer your prayers at the Ram Janaki Temple, visit Biwah Mandap, Hanuman Mandir, Ganga Sagar, and feel your soul connect with the footprints of Lord Ram and Mata Sita.


Finally, conclude your journey with panoramic blessings at Chandragiri Hills by ropeway — a perfect end to a pilgrimage rooted in faith, ritual, and breathtaking Himalayan beauty.


Sacred Temples & Shaktipeeths

- Pashupatinath Temple Jyotirlinga of Lord Shiva and Nepal's most revered Shaivite shrine
- Guhyeshwari Shaktipeeth Divine seat of Goddess Parvati, deeply connected to tantric traditions
- Budhanilkantha Temple Majestic idol of Lord Vishnu in a sleeping posture, floating on water
- Bindabasini Temple, Pokhara Devoted to Goddess Durga, nestled in the lap of the Himalayas
- Manakamana Temple Wish-fulfilling Shaktipeeth reached via scenic cable car ride
- Muktidham (Muktinath Temple) Himalayan moksha kshetra with 108 holy water spouts for divine cleansing
- Jwala Mai Temple, Muktinath Eternal flame temple, where fire, water, and earth coexist miraculously
- Kumari Temple (Living Goddess) Glimpse Nepal's unique living deity tradition in Kathmandu Durbar Square
- Personalized gotra-based pooja at Muktinath
- Rudrabhishek, Gita Path, or Shraddh Vidhi by Jipanditji Pandits




Enjoy a peaceful overnight stay and dinner in Pokhara, resting well for the adventures ahead.

After breakfast, board your flight from Kathmandu to the holy city of Janakpur Dham. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel and take some time to refresh.


In the evening, immerse yourself in the divine ambiance of Janakpur with visits to its most revered sites:


- Ram Janaki Temple The legendary temple dedicated to Lord Rama and Goddess Sita, symbolizing eternal love and devotion.

Day 09: Departure from Kathmandu


